AGRSS Registration Reaches 1000

The Automotive Glass Replacement Safety Standards (AGRSS) Council has announced that its list of registered shop has now surpassed 1000 locations.

“We topped 1000 shops last week,” said Jean Pero, chair of the AGRSS registered company development committee. “In just the last few weeks we’ve had more than 15 companies register, reflecting a growing commitment to the industry and making the industry stronger, better.”

“Hawaii remains the only state without representation,” she added. “Three companies in New Mexico signed up shortly after our last announcement, so now we have nearly every state in the union represented in AGRSS registration.”

The Automotive Glass Replacement Safety Standards Council, Inc., is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to the safe replacement of auto glass. AGRSS was founded and is supported by companies in the auto glass replacement industry that keep safe installation as their primary goal.

AGRSS is an accredited American National Standards Institute (ANSI)-standards development organization. It has developed the world’s only auto glass replacement safety standard, the AGRSS standard (ANSI/AGRSS 002-2002 Automotive Glass Replacement Safety Standard). The AGRSS Standard addresses procedures and education.
